[Securities Lawyer's Deskbook](#)

This site provides full text of selected federal statutes and their related regulations and forms, such as Securities Act of 1933, its rules and forms, Securities Exchange Act of 1934, its rules and forms, Regulation S-K, Regulation S-B, Regulation S-T, and Regulation S-X.

[EDGAR](#)

EDGAR, the U.S. Securities Exchange Commission (SEC)'s Electronic Data Gathering, Analysis, and Retrieval system, performs automated collection, validation, indexing, acceptance, and forwarding of submissions by companies and others who are required by law to file forms with the SEC. This site allows retrieval of publicly available filings submitted to the SEC from January 1995 to the present. Non-electronic filings, and filings made prior to 1995, will not be available here.

[U.S. Small Business Administration](#)

Provides full text of the Small Business Act as amended in 1996, the Small Business Regulatory Enforcement Act of 1996. In addition, this site offers information and resources helpful to small businesses, Small Business Administration regional offices, and links to other websites.

Provides full-text of the most frequently requested federal tax forms, instructions and publications. Also supplies links to sites where state tax forms and other information is available.
